Erection of Steel Framed Barn for schooling of horses and storage of straw (part retrospective) Homefield Barn, Dauntsey.

Due to the design of the barn Members do not consider the building suitable for the proposed use, as if equestrian use is proposed it would require a change of use from the previous agricultural use. As there is a nearby watercourse the disposal of foul water would need to be addressed to prevent contamination. The installation of an impermeable surface requires that an adequate surface water drainage scheme should be agreed as the area is already prone to flooding

Erection of Agricultural storage building following demolition of 2 No. Chicken sheds at Corner Farm Sodom Lane, Dauntsey

Members are objecting to this application as they are unsure of the proposed use, no agricultural activities are being carried out on the site and the current use of the site would require a change of use prior to consideration of the new building.
